Ages 6 & Under: More than 30 kids played in this group and made great strides developing basic soccer skills as well as principles of fitness and teamwork. Thanks to Coach Kenny Cooper and the many parents who helped make the fall season a success.

Ages 8 & Under: This group played in a semi-competitive 4 vs. 4 league and showed superior skill and teamwork and went undefeated during the season. Kudos to Coaches James Wilkinson and Ronnie Compton.

Ages 9 & Under: In this 5 vs. 5 league Coach Maria Robles' team showed continual improvement throughout the season against some of the toughest competition in the county.

Ages 10 & Under: Despite struggling in its previous two seasons, Coaches Denise Nadasen and Ralph Dubayah helped guide this group to a record of 4-3-1 and a third place finish in their division.

Ages 12 & Under: Last year's U10 county co-champs struggled a bit this season as they were forced to play up a year in the county's U12 division. Nonetheless Coach Tino Menjivar's team finished with a record of 4-3-1 and should be well positioned to compete for a county championship again next year.
